Laundry can be arranged through school if necessary. • Arrange a Coach and Manager per team – by contacting parents and checking their availability to help and their cleared volunteer status. • Arrange all coaches by the end of April as Coaches attend compulsory meeting (venue to be advised). • Liaise with the College Communications Team to provide information to families to register their child/ren with NWJSA online. • Be available as required via email. • Liaise with the Head of Sport • Organise and order medals for participation, to be given out at the last game. • Work with the Head of Sport to help facilitate the end of year presentation. • You will need to have, or be working towards, being an approved College volunteer including appropriate clearances, and child safety training.
